

Crash Information

- Vehicle A, a Toyota Highlander was driving north on Old Grissom Road and prepared to take a left turn to go west onto Grissom Road, thinking that approaching Vehicle B was preparing to turn.
- Vehicle B, a Lexus IS, was actually traveling east in the outer lane of Grissom Road and hit the Highlander as it pulled out into the intersection.
- The crash occurred at 5:59pm on May 12, 2023
 - There were no fatalities.
- Weather reports tell us it was cloudy in the mid 80s that evening.





Crash Information

- The speed limit on Grissom Road is 45 miles per hour (mph); the limit on Old Grissom Road is 35 mph.
- The crash report does not indicate if witness statements were gathered
 - Surveillance seems unlikely given the location
- The crash report listed damage severity for both cars at a 4 out of 7.


Crash Details

- The crash report indicates that the primary factor was failure to yield during a left turn
- According to the report and media coverage, no one was injured during the crash
- Drug and alcohol specimens were listed as "none"

Overall Site Conditions

- Grissom Road is a 5 lane roadway at this location
 - Grissom Road has 4 through traffic lanes two eastbound and two westbound
 - At this intersection, Grissom Road has a center turning lane dedicated to westbound traffic turning left onto Old Grissom Road.
- The intersection is unsignalized; however the City has funded a project to install a signal at this intersection during 2024
- There are no marked crosswalks





Overall Site Conditions

- Suburban Development Pattern with a mixture of residential and commercial properties
- Located within a diamond of state highways (Texas 151, the 1604 loop, & Texas 16) and Interstate 410
- Grissom Road connects to the 1604 loop on its western end and Texas 16 on its eastern end
- Two elementary schools and a middle school nearby this intersection






 Preliminary Speed Study indicates significant number of automobiles traveling at fatal speeds
